In particular, the role will require a thorough understanding of large WTG models, application of WTG parameters during the initial project development phases, knowledge of the supply chain and market conditions and the procurement process for TSAs and WTG service concepts.

- Provide the required WTG input to the project packages and effectively interface with them
- Carry out technical bid reviews and tender evaluations
- Ability to create time schedules, CAPEX and OPEX estimates for the WTG Package
- Experience in Change Management and ability to cooperate with the Commercial team
- Risk identification and management of WTG work streams
- Reporting and liaison with stakeholders both at corporate and stakeholder level
